

DIVIDEND MANDATE INSTRUCTION

Instructions to pay dividends direct to your bank or building society

There are a number of advantages in having your dividends paid direct to your bank or building society rather than by a cheque:

- You will have the money paid into your account immediately without it being lost or delayed in the post, and without you having to take or send your dividend cheque to your bank or building society
- It will avoid the risk of mislaying or accidentally destroying your dividend cheque
- If paid via BACS the tax voucher will be sent to your address.
