Communisis Centre of Excellence Official Opening – 6th July 2007

Leading print and print management group, Communisis, officially open their new Centre of Excellence on the Estuary Commerce Park, Speke, Liverpool today. The ceremony will be performed by Maria Eagle, MP for Liverpool Garston, at 1 p.m.

The new 100,000 sq. ft state-of-the-art facility for the production of transactional documents, including statements and bills, has been purpose built using the latest technology and is the largest of its kind anywhere in Europe. Unique in the printing industry, when fully fitted out, the site will boast the most sophisticated software and hardware systems available to create a fully secure automated document factory with a zero tolerance of failure.

Total investment in the site will be over £17 million over the multi-year terms of customer contracts.

Communisis is now a leading player in the statement and billing market having won two of the biggest outsourcing contracts that have come to market during the last 18 months.

The purpose built facility has been developed to the highest level of environmental requirements and the company is committed to minimising its impact on the environment by setting demanding targets. Raw materials are sourced from sustainable resources. These include recycled and Forestry Stewardship Council (FSC) accredited..

Communisis has already transferred skilled staff from customers in the region and has plans to expand the operation to create further jobs. It is expected that 500 people will be employed on site by 2008.

The attractive Estuary Commerce Park was chosen as it is a prime location, close to motorway networks and Liverpool airport and is a pleasant environment for staff.
